

## Terms and conditions of sale

Each lot will be sold with no fees to the highest bidder.

The hammer price of each lot is equal to the amount of the second highest bid plus 2% (rounded up to nearest euro).

For example: if the two highest bids for a single lot are 500€ and 600€, the lot will be sold for 510€ to the collector who bid 600€.

Identical *bids* are determined by draw

In the case of a single bid for a lot, said lot will be sold at the minimum starting price.

If the difference between the two highest bids is less than 2 %, the lot will be sold at the price of the highest bid.

Any bid below the starting price will not be accepted

Unless otherwise specified, the numbering system used is that of the Yvert & Tellier catalogue.

For two similar stamps that form two lots labeled “TB” (“Très Beau”, i.e., “Very Fine”), two different minimum prices indicate that the stamp with the highest minimum price is of superior quality.

Shipping is done immediately after the date of the closing of the sale, upon reception of payment. Stamps are sent via registered mail with insurance and philatelic postage. You will be required to contribute with a 7€ flat fee for shipments within mainland France; and a 15€ flat fee for shipments outside of France.

The stamps remain property of La Postale until full payment has been made. Pictures from the catalogue are for the description of centering, margins, and the general quality of the stamps. In case of non-conforming items, the stamp can be returned within 7 days after its reception by the receiver, except for lots and collections. In case of dispute, only the Commercial court of Paris has the authority to rule.

A photographic certificate of authenticity can be sent upon request for any stamp whose value exceeds 400€.

It is possible to pay in four installments, free of charge. In order to pay in more than 4 installments, please contact us.

Payment may be made by check, in euros, bank card, money order or bank transfer.
